

Whereas, the Commissioners' Court **FINDS** that circumstances creating a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning no longer exist in the unincorporated areas of Galveston County located on Bolivar Peninsula.

Now, Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED, by the Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas, that the Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning in Unincorporated Areas of Galveston County, Texas that was issued on October 4, 2011 and which still remains in effect as to Bolivar Peninsula only is hereby **LIFTED** effective **IMMEDIATELY** on and from the adoption of this Order;

Be it FURTHER ORDERED, that the County Judge of Galveston County, or in the event of his absence, if such should be the case, that member of the Commissioners' Court serving as the Presiding Officer of this Meeting of the Commissioners' Court, is hereby **AUTHORIZED** to **EXECUTE** this Order on behalf of the Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas; and

Be it FURTHER ORDERED, that the County Clerk is **ORDERED** to transmit forthwith a copy of this Order to the Sheriff, Constables, and Criminal District Attorney of Galveston County, Texas.


Upon Motion Duly Made and Seconded, the above Order is hereby **ADOPTED**, on this, the 6th day of December, 2011.
