

After initial damage assessments and individual inspections have been completed and a final determination of substantial damage has occurred the following steps will be followed for permits:

- Step 1. Prepare scale plans of proposed work on letter size paper in conformance with Galveston County Floodplain Regulations.
- Step 2. Submit plans to Galveston County along with GLO, Health District and Entergy requirements and submit a signed permit application.

Completely Destroyed structures:

- With Pre-Ike bldg permit- If it can be verified that a County pre-Ike building permit had been issued and the structure was constructed per the permit, a permit to re-build that same structure can be issued after the GLO, Health District & Entergy requirements are satisfied. If the owner wants to build a new structure different than the pre-Ike permitted structure new plans will be required.
- Without Pre-Ike bldg permit- If a structure was built without a Pre-Ike County permit, a permit to re-build will be issued after plans are provided showing conformance with the County's floodplain regulations. GLO, Health District and Entergy requirements still apply.

Substantially Damaged Structures:

- With Pre-Ike building permit- If a County pre-Ike permit can be verified and the structure was built per the permit, a permit to re-build the same structure will be issued provided a new elevation certificate is submitted verifying the structure is properly elevated to the 100 year floodplain. All GLO, Health District and Entergy requirements will still apply.
- Without Pre-Ike building permit- If a structure was built without a County permit a permit to re-build the same structure will be issued after new plans are provided showing the structure will be required showing the structure will be elevated to the 100 floodplain elevation. GLO, Health District, and Entergy requirements still apply.

Non-Substantially Damaged Structures:

- With Pre-Ike building permit- If a county pre Ike building permit can be verified and the structure was constructed per the permit, a permit can be issued to re-build that same structure after GLO, Health District and Entergy requirements are satisfied.
- Without Pre-Ike building permit- This same procedure will be followed if a building permit cannot be verified provided an elevation certificate is provided and new plans are submitted showing the structure is elevated to the 100 year floodplain.

Non Damaged Structures:

- If a structure has been determined to have no damage, only GLO, Health District and Entergy requirements will need to be satisfied before permanent power can be released.

- Step 3. Construct the permitted structure in conformance with the new permit and comply with GLO, Health District, and Entergy requirements.
