

!! Important Storm Debris Notice !!

Galveston County (Bolivar Peninsula) has been approved for the FEMA Private Property Debris Removal (PPDR) program. It is also known as the Right of Entry (ROE) program. What does this mean for the citizens of Bolivar Peninsula? It means that you may be eligible to have your property clear of storm debris at no expense to you.

If your property is not insured by a private insurance company, you should apply for the Right of Entry program for assistance in clearing storm debris from the property. The Deadline for applying is December 31, 2008.

How do I apply for the PPDR program? There are two ways to apply.

- 1. You can visit the County website: www.co.galveston.tx.us and click on "Hurricane Ike Private Property Debris Removal Information". This will lead you to the necessary information about the program and an application to complete.**
- 2. You may also visit the Debris Removal Information office (White Trailer) setup behind the County Annex building on Crystal Beach Drive. At this location you will be provided with detailed information about the program and afforded the opportunity to complete and turn in your application with supporting documentation.**

The application process can be time consuming, but save you from the high cost of having the work done on your own with greater assurance the job will be completed to your satisfaction. The sooner you apply, the sooner the work can begin.
